
My product:


PERSONAL PROJECT - CREATING A GUIDEBOOK FOR THE GREEK ISLAND OF SANTORINI

Due to the fact that nobody in my family is interested in planning, it is my duty to prepare a detailed itinerary for every holiday trip we are going to take. It brings me great fun, since it demands a thorough research about destinations, which I am fond of doing.

When people hear the word "Greece", most of them imagine blue-domed, white houses. As a child, I was enchanted by this type of architecture. That is why I desperately wanted to visit the island that is often associated with this kind of buildings - Santorini. I managed to go there when I was eleven years old. I fell in love with this island and so did my parents. In consequence, we have visited Santorini every year since the time we first had the opportunity to admire it. Product

I will also have an opportunity to find out what a proper guidebook looks like and develop my designing skills. I visited Santorini a few times, so I already have a basic background knowledge, which will make it more simple to me while describing worth-seeing places.

MY PRODUCT AND LEARNING GOALS

From an early age I was spending time with my grandma who was crocheting. I find it very interesting and I decided to learn how to crochet as well.

My final product is a crocheting top. For my Personal Project I decided to do a crocheting part of clothing, further a top, which is a short type of blouse. It is made of jeans wool and a 3.5 mm hook. It has 2 cups in the same size, one down part including the decorate part and the strap. The strap is going to the shoulders and it is crossing on the back a few times. The cups are in triangle shape and they are made of 3 levels (in different colours) which are built accordingly like: 1st one is blue and it includes 7 rows, 2nd one is purple and it includes 6 rows and the last one is pink and it includes 11 rows. The down part includes 3 levels: 1st in the pink colour includes 8 rows, 2nd in the purple includes 8 rows, 3rd in the blue includes 7 rows and a decorative part.

The top is done with traditional and basic patterns. All stitches are more or less the same size and shape. The top looks esthetic. The colours fit each other. It is perfect for summer and it matches most of the clothes. The top, thanks to great wool, is not itchy. It is comfortable to wear and it feels really nice even when you are wearing it all day. My learning goals were connected with many things which come from crocheting. For my first learning goal I established that I will of course learn how to crochet. If you are developed in different ways, which include manual things, you can be self-sufficient and also you will probably find your job easier. So learning how to crochet is an opportunity to evolve my manual skills. Moreover I assumed that I will train my character and make it more resistant to stress situations. I also came to the conclusion that I want to make my fingers stronger to climb better.





SHORT CLIMBING GUIDE





Background information:


In 1920s Finnish government recognized the threat of Soviet union and they were close to signing a defensive pact including baltic countries and Poland but the pact broken up because of the finnish parliament, in 1932 they signed a nonaggression pact with Soviet Union but the threat was becoming even bigger even though they signed this treaty. After the Russo-German partition of Poland Russians next step was Finland and at the end of november 1939 the war started.

The Winter War

The war started on november 30 1939 when the soviet troops totaling to around one million troops attacked finland in various different places. Finns were greatly outnumbered but with the help of fighting on their own territory with addition to the season being winter they managed to hold on and soviets didn't manage to progress in winter. But in February of 1940 Soviets used artillery bombardment to breach Finnish southern defensive barrier (Mannerheim line), after which they continued their offensive northward to the Finnish city of Viipuri(Vyborg). Finland could secure help from Britain and France so because of their exhaustion they had to make peace with Soviets in the treaty of Moscow on march 12 1940 which was on the soviet terms. Later when Third Reich declared war on Soviet Union Finland joined Reich in this conflict (War of Continuation), but later they have withdrew from the conflict and signed armistice on september 19, 1944.







Programming a website about cybersecurity with database.




Figure 3. Database

This made me figure out my learning goal for my Personal Project. I desired to paint something meaningful and something that is truly mine. A painting that will provoke some thoughts and engagement from the viewer.

My product:

My final product is knitted fingerless gloves. They are made of high quality materials and consist of an additional cuff of the glove. During the work on gloves, I had handy the criteria and plan that I had done before to make sure that I was following the goals and deadlines that I had set. Thanks to it, I didn't forget about anything and could remember when which part of my process had to be done.

While making my product I developed my personality, which positively affects my overall effectiveness in my project and for sure will be useful in the future. I have become more knowledgeable, because I equiped myself with necessary knowledge in order to make the product. I did an in-depth research to be well - informed about a particular subject and I also evaluated the sources to make sure that this is worth and proper to use. Before knitting I have learned about different types of knitting patterns and the best materials to use. I chose stockinette stitch to knit the gloves, because it is the most basic and classic knitting stitch pattern for beginners. To knit the cuff I used a mistake rib stitch method, while I wanted to diversify my product by using a different pattern. During creating the product, I have learned with tutorials to cast-on, rib, cast off, seam and weave in the ends.

Secondly I was very motivated to achieve my goal and create the final product in the designated plan. I had to find some free time every week to train and focus on creating the product. Instead of wasting my free time on watching series or playing games, I spent the time on an activity that was pleasant and worth developing.

I also was the thinker who applied creative and critical thinking to solve the problems and gained the ability to make reasonable decisions. Even when I encountered the mistakes in pattern, I was determined to find it and spend some time analyzing and improving it.

In the end, the product was tested by questionnaires, where my family and friends were evaluating the design and success of the gloves. I analyzed the results and my own perceptions and came to the conclusion that the gloves are positively received by recipients. Nearly every questionnaire achieved 100 %, except with the question which refers to neatness. One person chose the option somewhat, which means that next time knitting clothes I should check if everything is made with precision and is

properly fitted.
